

Quria – Next generation Library Services Platform (LSP)

Axiell's Library Services Platform **Quria** is a linked data native library system that has been used in production since 2017.

Today over 300 public-, school- and special libraries in Sweden, Norway, Finland, Germany and Switzerland are users of Quria and the community is growing.

LDQ - Quria Linked Data

Based primarily on RDA Registry – with adjustments

Basic entities are work, expression, manifestation, item (WEMI)

Data driven format

LDQ in numbers

150-200 library collections converted to linked data (including major consortias)

15 million works in the environment

12 000 new works created every day

RDA – adjustments & data improvement

Access points for Contributors/Agents

Adaption of relationships

Adding language and target audience if missing

Adding vital missing values that are required for clustering entities

Why? - since data quality highly effects the result of linked data and entity creation!!






Local works, expression and manifestations; examples of the same title as work in two Quria-installations.

Since Quria is a local system, a Quria tenant use the system internal data to create WEMs.

No common database for WEMs. Every customer/library has their own "local" WEMs



Depending on the quality of the data, WEMs also match & merge differently.





Now the English translation is imported to Quria. The record is converted from MARC21 to LDQ and entities are matched and merged.


We perform the search again. Now the search result includes an *Arabic* title..


The subject headings are connected to the work, and thus valid for all underlying expressions


A concrete example of how metadata is more efficiently used when structured as RDAclasses.




Lack of creators, work-title, content-type - no automatic merge, due to risk of wrong-match.

Example of no automatic merge of the works – needs intellectual /manual handling.











Work/Expression has been merged.

Add work - or not?




Add record

Start with searching for a work to see if it needs to be added from start or just add a new expression or manifestation





Add/edit work, expression, manifestation
